Supply List

- Stamp Sets: Celebrate Sunflowers
- Cardstock: Crushed Curry, Soft Suede, Basic White, Garden Green, Pacific Point, Daffodil Delight
- Stampin Pads: Tuxedo Black Momento, Soft Suede, Crushed Curry, Garden Green, Shimmery White
- Misc: Scissors, Glue Dots, Stampin Dimensionals, Brick & Mortar 3D Embossing Folder, Old Olive & Sahara Sand Twill Ribbon, Water Painters, Masking Paper



Celebrate Sunflowers Stamp Set





Measurements for Cutting:

• Crushed Curry: 4 1/2" x 11" (Base),

• **Soft Suede: 4** 1/8" x 5 3/8"

• Whisper White: 5 1/4" x 4", Scrap White (to fit saying)

• Masking paper: 3 1/2" x 3 3/4"

• Shimmery White: 3 1/2" x 3 3/4"

• Garden Green: 3 5/8" x 3 7/8"

Instructions

- Take your Crushed Curry base and crease it in ½.
- Then take your Basic White 5 1/4" x 4" and adhere that to the inside of your base.
- Then take your Soft Suede card stock cut 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" to the big shot with the Brick & Mortar Embossing folder. Run Soft Suede thru the folder.
- Adhere the Soft Suede to the center of the top of the base.
- Take your scrap Basic White paper and stamp your saying in black. Then fussy cut out your saying and set it aside. Cut 7.5" of Sahara Sand ribbon and set it aside.
- Clear your station of all things except your paper to stamp on, your small and medium water brush, a separate mat for you to use with water so it doesn't mess up your cardstock, a paper towel then the following inks: Soft Suede, Crushed Curry, Garden Green, then the sunflower stamp on a block and the leaf stamp on a block.
- With your station neat and all your other card stock and supplies sitting to the side (so they don't get ink or wet), grab your 2 Basic White 3 1/2" x 3 3/4" pre cut pieces (one is masking paper, one is shimmery white)
- Use your Soft Suede ink and stamp on the masking paper. Then use your scissors to fussy cut that out as close to the ink as possibly. Once that is done set it aside, but close by we will be using it on the next step.
- Take your Shimmery White 3 1/2" x 3 3/4" and bring it to your station. We will be focusing on this for a while. Use soft suede ink and stamp the sunflower. It needs to be slightly up and to the right of your white paper. Now take your sunflower you just cut out and lay it perfectly on top of the sunflower you just stamped. Take garden green and the leaf and stamp that in the bottom left corner 2 times
- Remove your sunflower you used to mask. Then use the 3 ink pads (I push them in the middle so ink comes into the lid and use that side) to water color the images. I use Crushed Curry for the flower with the medium brush, Soft Suede for the center with the small brush and Garden Green for the leaves with the small brush
- Once it dries adhere the Basic White to the center of the Garden Green you have precut. Then use Stamping Dimensionals to adhere it to the center left side of your card base (on top of the bricks).
- Fold your ribbon and adhere that to the bottom right of the card. Add the image to the top of your card. For more information visit FlourishingFinishes.com | email: jill@flourishingfinishes.com
