- **Stamp Sets:** Epic Celebrations [Retired], Hey Birthday Chick [Retired]
- **Cardstock:** Basic Black, Basic Gray, Whisper White, Real Red, Pacific Point, Daffodil Delight
- **Stampin Pads:** Tuxedo Black Momento
- **Punches:** 1-3/8" Circle Punch [Retired], 1/2" Circle Punch, 1/4" Circle Punch [Retired]
- **Cut & Emboss:** Layering Ovals Dies [Retired], Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder, Give It A Whirl Dies
- **Misc:** Scissors, Adhesive, Stampin Dimensionals

Epic Celebrations Stamp Set



Measurements for Cutting:

- **Basic Black:** 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" (Base), 1 1/2" x 3/4" (Textured), 1 3/4" x 3", 1 3/8" Circle Punch x 2, 4th Smallest Layering Oval x 2
- **Basic Gray:** 5 1/4" x 4", 1/2" Circle Punch x 6, 1/4" Strip
- **Whisper White:** 5" x 3 3/4", 5 1/4" x 4"
- **Real Red:** 1/4" Circle Punch, Give It A Whirl Dies – Heart x 2
- **Daffodil Delight:** Give it Whirl Dies – Smallest Star x 2
- **Pacific Point:** 1/4" Circle Punch

Instructions

- Fold your black base in half and crease it nicely. Adhere the basic gray 5 1/4" x 4" layer to the front of the card.
- Pick your birthday stamps to put on the outside and inside. Stamp your saying on the outside on the white 5" x 3 3/4" piece towards the bottom center of the card. Stamp your sayings in the inside white 5 1/4" x 4" piece. Adhere both of those to your card.
- Run the basic black 1 1/2" x 3/4" piece through your Stampin' Up Cut & Emboss Machine using the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
- Punch out all of your pieces using the punches/dies.
- Take the basic gray 1/4" strip and cut 4 pieces at 3/8" for the directional buttons. Snip the end of one side to make the arrow shape.
- Lay your middle rectangle piece and 2 oval pieces on top of your card lining up the sizing of the remote. Adhere those together. Then build all your other punches to complete your remote.
- Use Stampin' dimensionals on the back of the remote to adhere it to the upper part of the top of the card.

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
