Supply List

- **Stamp Sets:** Ranunculus Romance, Hey Birthday Chick [Retired]
- **Cardstock:** Basic Black, Real Red, Cherry Cobbler, Whisper White
- **Stampin Pads:** Tuxedo Black Momento, Cherry Cobbler
- **Misc:** Scissors, Adhesive, Gray Granite 1/4" Shimmer Ribbon, Stampin' Dimensionals, Multipurpose Liquid Glue



Ranunculus Romance Stamp Set



Measurements for Cutting:

- **Basic Black:** 4 1/4" x 11" (Base), 5 x 3 3/4", 2 3/4" x 4 1/4"
- **Whisper White:** 5 1/4" x 4", 4 3/4" x 3 1/2", 2 1/2" x 4"
- **Real Red:** 2" x 5 1/4"
- **Cherry Cobbler:** 2" x 5 1/4"

Instructions

- Crease your base (4 1/4" x 11") in 1/2.
- Grab your 2 red 2" x 5 1/4" pieces. Adhere the Cherry Cobbler (darker red) to the left front of the base, leaving a little black edge. Then adhere the Real Red to the right of the base front in the same way.
- Adhere the white 5 1/4" x 4" into the inside center of the card. Then adhere your black 5" x 3 3/4" to the center of the inside of your card. Then set aside your card base. You should then have left 1 Basic White 4 3/4" x 3 1/2", 1 Basic White 2 1/2" x 4" and 1 Basic Black 2 3/4" x 4 1/4"
- Get out the flower stamp and the Cherry Cobbler ink pad. Stamp the top portion of the flower on the bottom left of the Basic White 4 3/4" x 3 1/2". Then take this and adhere it to the center of the inside of your card.
- Take the Basic White 2 1/2" x 4" and stamp the whole flower on the top center of the white. Leaving room on the bottom for the saying.
- Get your Tuxedo Black ink pad and the Just for You stamp and stamp the bottom center of the white.
- Take that white and adhere it to the center of the Basic Black 2 3/4" x 4 1/4". Use dimensionals and pop that to the center of the top of your card.
- Take your ribbon and use enough to tie a bow and glue it to the bottom stem of the flower on the front of the card.

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
